

WHAT IS IT?

Extended NEXT (EN) coverage for Detroit engines is intended for fleets and owner-operators currently covered by our EW1, EW2, EW3, or EW4 Detroit Extended Coverage plans. Add 1 year/125k miles or 2 years/250k miles of OEM service protection.* Towing coverage is included.**



WHY IS IT VALUABLE?

Fleets and owner-operators remain protected by their same reliable Freightliner or Western Star service network. It's a great strategy for extending the trade cycle of your current vehicles. It also enhances the resale value of your trucks because coverage carries over to the next owner with no added fees.



WHAT PACKAGES ARE OFFERED?

EN2, EN3, and EN4 give you coverage options from basic to comprehensive. You're able to upgrade, downgrade, or keep a similar level of coverage as your current EW1, EW2, EW3, or EW4 extended service coverage plan.



HOW DO TRUCKS QUALIFY?

- DD13®, DD15®, and DD16® are eligible once the base warranty has expired and the EW1, EW2, EW3, or EW4 Extended Service Coverage plan becomes active.
- The engine must be in its original chassis and must match the vocation on the original vehicle product registration.
- The combination of original Extended Service Coverage plus Extended NEXT coverage cannot exceed 7 years or 750,000 miles/1,207,500 km.
- Coverage expires based on the time/duration purchased, or once the time or mileage has reached the 7-year/750,000-mile (1,207,500 km) limit, whichever comes first. Extended NEXT coverage begins from the original in-service date (not from the contract purchase date) and activates once EW expires.
- An Inspect and Repair form is required for upgrading from EW1 to EN2 or EW3 to EN4 and is valid for 30 days from inspection and/or repair date.
